

GERALDINE HIGH SCHOOL BYOD AGREEMENT

1. Any student who wishes to use a personally owned electronic device within Geraldine High School must read and agree to this agreement
2. The student takes full responsibility for his or her device and keeps it with himself or herself at all times or locked in an allocated locker. The school is not responsible for the security of the device.
3. The student is responsible for the proper care of his or her personal device, including any costs of repair, replacement or any modifications needed to use the device at school. Geraldine High School does not supply technical support for student owned devices.
4. The school reserves the right to inspect the student's personal device if there is reason to believe that the student has violated Board policies, administrative procedures, school rules or has engaged in other misconduct while using their personal device.
5. Violations of any Board policies, administrative procedures or school rules involving a student's personally owned device may result in the loss of use of the device in school and/or disciplinary action.
6. The student complies with teachers' request to shut down the computer or close the screen.
7. The personal device will be charged prior to bringing it to school and will be capable of running off its own battery while at school.
8. The student may not use the devices to record, transmit or post photos or video of a person or persons at school without the express permission of a teacher and the person being photographed or videoed.
9. During school hours the student will only use their device to access classroom related activities.
10. The student will use the school wireless network. Any use of the internet to access inappropriate material will be subject to school or police action.
11. The device must be on silent mode while on the campus, unless sound is required for a specific task by the teacher.
12. The device may not be used by other students while at school.
13. Use of personal devices during summative assessments is not permitted and students violating this may forfeit their assessment grade.
