

GERALDINE HIGH SCHOOL

ENROLMENT SCHEME

Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below (and shown on the attached map) shall be entitled to enrol at the school.

Addresses on both sides of boundary roads are included within the zone.

For enrolments in Year 7&8:

From the Withells Road / Rangitata Highway (SH1) intersection;

- South-East on Ealing Road until Old Main South Road
- South-West on Old Main South Road, to the Rangitata River
- South-East along the south bank of the Rangitata River to the river mouth
- South-West to Rangitata Huts Road
- South-West on Rangitata Huts Road to Orton Rangitata Mouth Road
- North-West on Orton Rangitata Mouth Road to Badham Road
- South-West on Badham Road to Farm Road
- South-West on Farm Road to Factory Road
- West on Factory Road to the Orari River
- North along the north-east bank of the Orari River to Ohapi Settlement Road
- West on Ohapi Settlement Road to Muff Road
- North on Muff Road to Coker Road
- West on Coker Road to Winchester-Orari Highway
- South on Winchester-Orari Highway to Beeby Road
- West on Beeby Road to Wilks Road (including Palk Road)
- West on Wilks Road to Winchester Hanging Rock Road
- South on Winchester Hanging Rock Road to Goodwin Road
- West on Goodwin Road to Seven Sisters Road
- South on Seven Sisters Road to Rangatira Valley Road
- West on Rangatira Valley Road to Galbraith Road,
- North West on Galbraith Road to Saddle Road
- North West on Saddle Road to Limestone Road
- North West on Limestone Road to Winchester Hanging Rock Road
- West on Winchester Hanging Rock Road to Rapuwai Road
- West on Rapuwai Road to Wigley Road
- West on Wigley Road to Ley Road
- West on Ley Road to the Opuha River
- North along the eastern bank of the Opuha River to the Geraldine-Fairlie Highway
- From the Geraldine-Fairlie Highway bridge over the Opuha River due North to the western end of Te Moana Road,
- From the western end of Te Moana Road north east to the western end of Leishman Road, then the north western end of Waihi Gorge Road, Orari River Road, and Blandswood Road,

- From the Western end of Blandswood Road, East along Blandswood Road (including Lookout Road and Bushman Road) to Rangitata Gorge Road.
- North on Rangitata Gorge Road to Mt Peel Church Road.
 - Including all addresses on Mt Peel Church Road,
 - All addresses accessed from Rangitata Gorge Road north of this point are included in the zone
- From the Mt Peel Church Road / Rangitata Gorge Road intersection south-east across the Rangitata River to the Shepherds Bush Road /Moorhouse Road intersection,
- South East on Shepherds Bush Road until the intersection with Arundel Rakaia Gorge Road / Barnswood Road
- South East on Barnswood Road until Lismore School Road (including Pineview Road)
- North East on Lismore School Road until Lismore Mayfield Road
- South on Lismore Mayfield Road until the intersection with Cracroft Maronan Road / Maronan Ealing Road
- South West on Maronan Ealing Road until Withells Road
- South East on Withells Road until the Rangitata Highway (SH1)

For enrolments in Years 9-15:

The Year 7&8 zone area described above, as well as all addresses in the area between the Rangitata and Hinds Rivers, South-East of Lismore School Road / Trevors Road.

Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date which will be published in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places which can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

Out of zone enrolments

Each year the board will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following year for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The board will publish this information by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.

Applications for enrolment will be processed in the following order of priority:

The order of priority in which applicants who live outside a school's home zone are to be offered places at the school is as follows:

- (a) first priority must be given to any applicant who is accepted for enrolment in a special programme run by the school: (Note that this priority category does

not apply at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary.)

- (b) second priority must be given to any applicant who is the sibling of a current student of the school:
- (c) third priority must be given to any student who is the sibling of a former student of the school:
- (d) fourth priority must be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school:
- (e) fifth priority must be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school:
- (f) sixth priority must be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, fifth or sixth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by a ballot conducted in accordance with instructions issued by the Secretary under Section 11G(1) of the Education Act 1989. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school.
